BASIC RECYCLING RULES:

Everything you recycle should be clean, dry, and unbagged!

the only thing that can be bagged is shredded paper



PAPER

Recycle This:

Office Paper/Schoolwork
Newspapers
Brown Paper Bags
Magazines
Junk Mail
Phone Books
Wrapping Paper

Don't Recycle This:

Wax Paper Used Napkins/Paper Towels Dryer Sheets



PLASTIC

Recycle This:

Clean #1 or #2 Plastic Bottles & Containers

Look for the symbols on the containers to tell you what number they are.

Don't Recycle This:

Plastics that are not #1 or #2
Ziplock Bags
Bubble Wrap
Cereal Box Bags
Plastic Wrap
Grocery Bags
Candy Wrappers



GLASS

Recycle This:

Clean Bottles
Clean Jars

Don't Recycle This:

Light Bulbs Broken Lights Tempered Glass Ceramics



MISCELLANEOUS

Recycle This:

Aluminum Cans Empty Aerosol Cans

Don't Recycle This:

Leftover Food
Clothing
Pillows/Blankets
Electronics
Medical Supplies
Paint
Pizza Boxes
Styrofoam
Clothes Hangers

WHERE TO RECYCLE

Curbside Recycling Programs:

- 1) The City of College Station offers curbisde recycling to residents and businesses in College Station. Contact them for more information.
- 2) The City of Bryan does not offer curbside recycling.
- **3**) Private businesses, such as BVR, will come to your home and pickup your recycling for a monthly fee. Contact them for more information.

Free Recycling Drop-Off Locations:

- 1) 174 Adriance Lab Road in College Station is drop off bins that accept paper, plastics, glass, aluminum, cardboard
- 2) Best Buy: Various Recycle Bins
- 3) Target: Various Recycle Bins
- 4) HEB: Plastic Grocery Bag Recycling (do not put plastic grocery bags in with your curbside recyclables!)
