This scholarship serves to offer financial aid to local graduating high school seniors from Brazos County who have demonstrated a passion for the Keep Brazos Beautiful mission or are pursuing a field of study that will make a positive impact on the environment. \$2,500 in scholarships will be awarded to local graduating high school seniors and can be used towards any accredited college or university.

Who can apply? Any graduating senior attending a public, private or homeschool in Brazos County.

Other Requirements:

- ☐ Applicants must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher. A transcript will be required upon submission.
- ☐ Applicants must be accepted into an accredited college or university. Acceptance letter will be required upon submission.
- ☐ Applicants will need a letter of recommendation from a teacher or organization leader.
- ☐ Applicants will need to write a short essay (500 word max) responding to the following questions:
 - What is your background, goals after high school, intended field of study, and how this will impact the community?
 - o What interests you about Keep Brazos Beautiful's Mission?
 - What actions have you taken, projects have you worked on, and/or organizations have you been involved in that have contributed to the beautification, recycling, litter abatement, or conservation of the community?
